India, as a member to the World Commerce Organization and the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade, is obligated to open its educational market to foreign trade, since higher education in India is not provided free of charge. Students are required to pay tuition in order to get an education. The International Trade Organization and the General Agreement on Trade in Services (GATS) have successfully globalised world economies. Globalization has ushered in the free movement of commerce, technology, information, and other goods and services across nations. 
