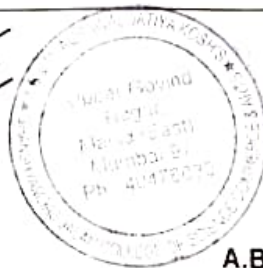



The best part of the workshop was that the students were given hand on training on how to prepare a vermicompost bin . Even the minute detailing was presented with the help of Powerpoint.

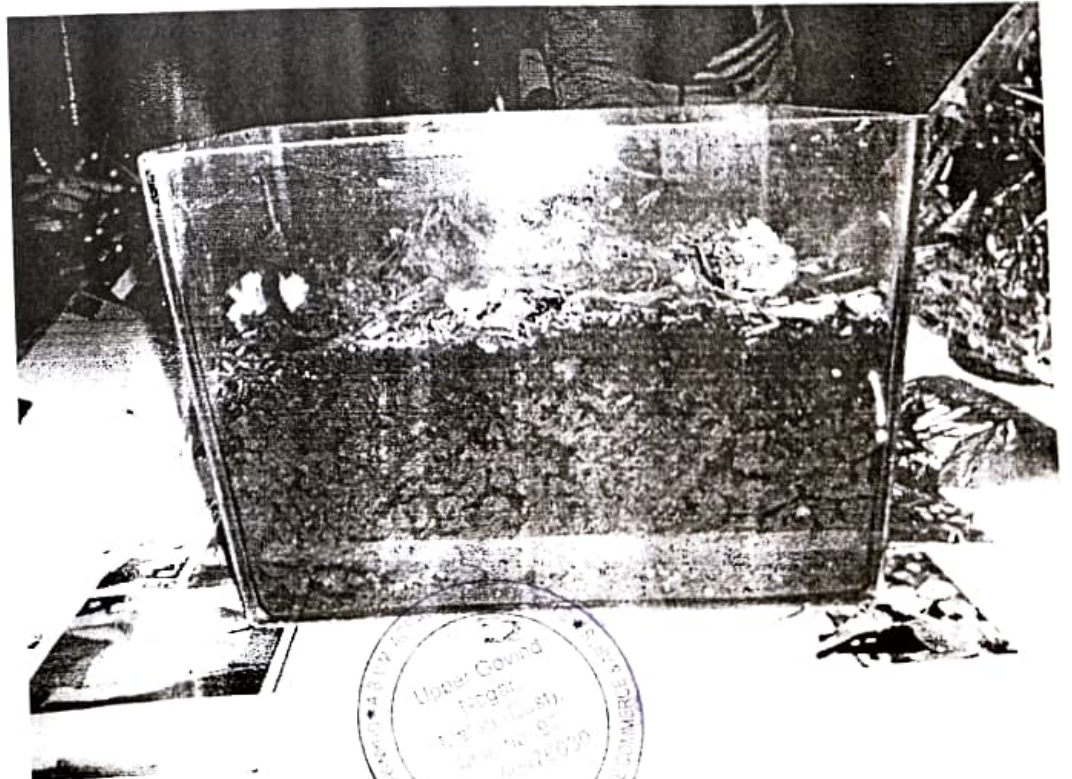
